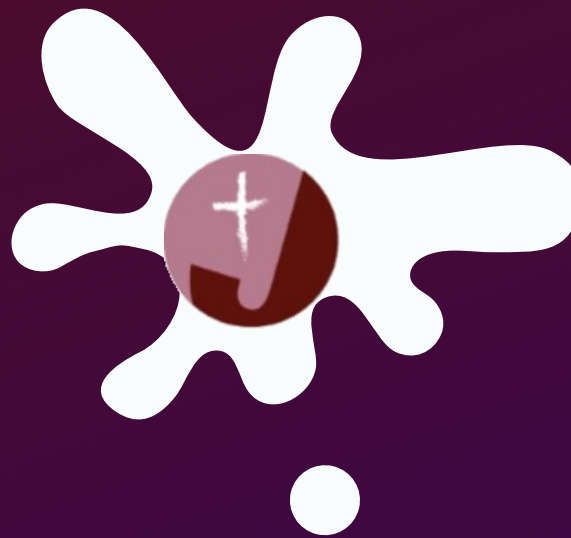

How Much Does it Cost?

The week costs \$325.00 / person. Participants are responsible for all transportation, traveling meals, snacks, spending money and Lunch during the Border Pilgrimage Day.
